Netflix will also have to face complex rules in France, where a film cannot be streamed on a subscription video service until three years after its release. But Netflix has some success competing in Europe, with more than 1.5m UK subscribers and 12.7 million users outside the United States. Details on programming and pricing in each country will be announced later, though in the UK, Netflix costs 5.99 pounds a month while a subscription in the Netherlands costs 8.99 euros (7.28 pounds) a month. The costs of launching in the new markets will keep Netflix's international unit at a loss, the firm said in a letter to shareholders in April. T = Technicals on the Stock Chart Are Mixed Netflix stock has struggled to make significant progress over the last couple of months. However, the stock is currently surging higher and looks set to continue. Analyzing the price trend and its strength can be done using key simple moving averages. What are the key moving averages? The 50-day (pink), 100-day (blue), and 200-day (yellow) simple moving averages. Netflix and Amazon Prime Video both support 4K streaming, though only for select titles - mostly original content rather than traditional Hollywood fare. To stream in 4K through Netflix, you'll need to purchase the top-tier subscription options, while Amazon Prime Video offers 4K streaming by default with its standard subscription. Apple TV+ offers titles in 4K video quality as well. So does Disney+ on selected titles. Just keep in mind that streaming in 4K can chew through quite a large chunk of data: On Netflix, an hour of 4K streaming uses up roughly 7GB. A basic Netflix subscription will set you back \$9.99 a month, but this only gets you the ability to stream to 1 device at a time and limits you to streaming in SD. A standard package costs \$13.99, which gives you access to HD and 2 screens at the same time, while a premium plan buys you 4K quality and simultaneous streaming on 4 screens for \$16.99 a month. Crave isn't far behind Netflix, with a pricier subscription than some other streaming services, especially if you get the add-ons. hayu, Acorn TV and Sundance Now have the clear price advantage on Netflix, charging just \$5.99, \$7.49 and \$6.99 a month respectively. The catch here is that hayu only allows you to stream to one device at a time and both have a much smaller content library than Netflix. Your choice of viewing is also limited, as hayu has a library filled with only reality TV content and Acorn TV has a library stocked with British content. Sundance Now has a focus on indie films and documentaries, which is suited toward the viewer with eclectic taste. The same goes for Shudder, another niche streaming service. Newer players like Apple TV+ cost less than Netflix, but you won't get the same generous library. Disney+ comes with a large content catalogue and doesn't break the bank. At the end of the day, it all depends on which type of content you like to watch. Content is king in the streaming video space and Netflix has a sizeable lead on the competition in terms of the number of TV shows and movies it offers. That said, quality is always more important than quantity and there are plenty of top-notch titles available exclusively on Crave, Amazon Prime Video and Sundance Now.
