Note: Inputs will NOT be fully styled if their type is not properly declared! The following example contains two input elements; one of type="text" and one of type="password". The following example contains a dropdown list (select list): Select list: 1 2 3 4 Try it Yourself » Form Control Sizing Change the size of the form control with .form-control-sm or .form-control-lg; Try it Yourself » Form Control with Plain Text Use the .form-control-plaintext if you want to style the input field as plain text; Try it Yourself » Form Control File and Range Add the .form-control-range class to input type="range" or .form-control-file to input type="file" to style a range control or a file field with full-width; Try it Yourself » Bootstrap 4 Radio Buttons in form tutorial is going to be discussed in this tutorial. As we know, Radio buttons allow a user to choose one option among other options using HTML forms. Bootstrap is a free and open-source UI framework. It was developed using HTML, CSS, and JavaScript, and it provides beautiful and cross-browser compatible UI components e.g., forms, buttons, menus, typography, and many more. Creating radio buttons with Bootstrap 4 is very easy, you have to add the radio input class in your radio buttons. Alternatively, if you want to add new style in your radio buttons, then you can use the third-party plug-ins as well.Set up Bootstrap Library in Your ProjectTo work with radio buttons using Bootstrap, we need to set up and configure Bootstrap 4 UI library in our project. I suggest you to use Bootstrap CDN to set up Bootstrap in your project. Paste the below code in the header part of your HTML file. Bootstrap Starter Template Example Adding custom styling to radio buttons in bootstrap can easily be done using 3rd party plug-ins and custom css. I will create a custom style and add it to style radio buttons in Bootstrap.Add the following code in your HTML template.
